

## City of Jonesville Planning Commission 2019 Work Plan

The Planning Commission annually develops a proposed work plan to identify its upcoming priorities. The approved plan will be submitted to City Council. The proposed plan, below, is provided in accordance with the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, Public Act 33 of 2008.

With the anticipated completion of the updated Master Plan in early 2019 and the recent engagement in the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) Redevelopment Ready Communities (RRC) program, the 2019 work plan is focused on those activities needed to implement the plan and further development readiness.

  - Develop Planning Commission skill set sheet

- Redevelopment Ready Sites
  - Support DDA and Council efforts to market and redevelop Klein Tool
  - Work with willing property owners to identify and market additional priority sites
- Economic Development Strategy
  - Annually review the Strategy with other development boards and committees
- Marketing Strategy
  - Support City Council and others to develop an overarching marketing strategy for the City
- Infrastructure Planning and Development
  - Complete parks concept plans and cost estimating
  - Conduct annual review of Capital Improvements Program for consistency with community development objectives
