The meeting was called to order at 5:20 p.m. by Chair Andy Penrose.

Motion by Brenda Guyse, second by Tim Bowman to approve the agenda, as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Brenda Guyse, second by Kathi Boyle, to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2020 meeting, as presented. Motion carried.

Nominations for Citizen of the Year and Youth Citizen of the Year were discussed and evaluated. Motion by Kathy Adams, second by Brenda Guyse, to recommend that the City Council name Ray Leising and Dave Pope 2020 Citizens of the Year and Hayden James and Carson Laney 2020 Youth Citizens of the Year. Motion carried.

The nominations will be presented to the City Council for their consideration at the March 18th Council meeting.

Gray noted that Olivia's Chop House has been confirmed for the Awards Ceremony on April 22nd at 6:00 p.m. He provided an updated budget that reflects an additional \$50.00 room charge for the event. This is the first increase in costs for the room since the program moved to Olivia's. It was the consensus of the committee that the costs are reasonable for the service provided.

Additional planning for the Awards Ceremony will take place after Council considers the Committee recommendation.

The \$120 Hayes memorial donation was discussed briefly. The Committee will continue to consider an appropriate honor for those funds to benefit the Awards Program as event planning takes place. The Committee will make a recommendation to Council regarding the expenditure.
