A City of Jonesville Cemetery Committee meeting was held on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 at the Sunset View Cemetery, Jonesville, MI. Chairman Shea Dow called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Cemetery Committee members present were: Brenda Guyse, Les Hutchinson, John Center, Shea Dow, Charlie Pfau, and Mike Kyser.

Also present: Manager Jeff Gray and Sexton Tyler Butters.

Les Hutchinson led the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence.

A motion was made by Les Hutchinson and supported Brenda Guyse to approve the agenda as presented. All in favor. Absent: Brenda Rathbun. Motion carried.

4. C. Sexton Services Agreement

[Action]

The current three-year agreement for services with Butters Excavating and Lawn Care for sexton services and property maintenance will expire at the end of March. City staff are very pleased with the services that we have received. Tyler Butters and I met recently to discuss a new contract.

Tyler is proposing an increase in the annual charge for mowing and leaf services from the current \$28,500 to \$34,500. He originally proposed an additional charge of \$2,500 for the additional area acquired from the school, but is willing to reduce that charge to \$2,000 since our staff is going to remove all of the existing trees to make property maintenance and eventual development simpler.

Increases are also proposed in all burial charges. The charge for cremation burials will allow for the burial of up to two cremains at one time on a single grave site. The charge for all weekend burials will be \$200. The increases are necessary to address increasing costs. The impact on customer charges is illustrated in the proposed fee schedule, which will be addressed in the next agenda item. Tyler plans to attend the meeting to discuss any questions that the committee may have.

I recommend a motion to recommend that the City Council approve a two-year contract, beginning April 1st. *Please refer to the attached proposals for mowing and for grave openings and closings.*

4. D. Cemetery Fee Schedule

[Action]

If the Committee recommends the proposed contract, it will be necessary to amend the Cemetery Fee Schedule. The amendments are shown in the attachment. Deletions are shown in strikeout and additions in bold/highlight. The \$50 difference in the fee from the proposed sexton charge is intended to address administrative costs for burial, including operation of our system database and staff time. I recommend a motion to recommend that the City Council approve the revised Fee Schedule, effective April 1st. *Please refer to the attached fee schedule*.

4. E. Election of Officers

[Action]

The Cemetery Committee elects a Chair and Vice-Chair annually at the first meeting of the calendar year. Shea Dow is the current Chair and Charlie Pfau is the current Vice-Chair. Officers may be re-elected. A motion is necessary to select a Chair and Vice-Chair for 2023.

An additional burial charge will apply to burials on other City recognized holidays, which include: President's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, the Day after Thanksgiving.

The City permits formal observances by local organizations on the patriotic holidays in the Cemetery; those wishing to schedule burials on these holidays will need to coordinate funeral times with the City.
