

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR CITIZENSHIP AWARD:

- 1. Community Involvement:** The candidate must have actively participated in community oriented projects that have been beneficial to the community as a whole.
- 2. Impact of Activities:** The candidate's activities must impact or have the potential to impact in a positive manner a significant portion of our community.
- 3. Leadership:** The candidate must demonstrate drive and initiative in his/her approach and overcoming challenges along the way.
- 4. Volunteerism:** The candidate has volunteered a significant amount of non-paid time and energy to further a cause or issue with the welfare of the community being a high priority of the candidate.
- 5. Contributions of Time, Materials, Property, Ideas, etc.:** The candidate must not have expected anything in return for his/her actions in trying to generate positive results for the community.
- 6. Role Model/Reputation/Morals:** The candidate must have been a role model to Jonesville citizens in the demonstration of good moral conduct. If at any time after a candidate is chosen for the Citizenship Award they do not display these qualities, his/her name will be removed from the plaque listing the winners.
