2020 RESIDENTIAL CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP ACCEPTABLE/UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

ACCEPTABLE:

All bagged and containerized municipal solid waste. Bags and containers must weigh less than 50 lbs. Larger items such as: Furniture, mattresses, box springs, toys, bicycles, appliances*, home fixtures, and any other items as long as they are considered non-hazardous and can be safely lifted by two people. Latex Paints – Paint must be dried up in containers. (used sawdust, kitty litter or just leave the paint can open for a few days to dry out the contents. <u>The</u> <u>contents must be solid and dry to be taken</u>.

Modern is not allowed to unload vehicles or trailers.

UNACCEPTABLE:

No small loose items. Must be a bulk item or in a bag or box/container for collection. Boxes must weigh less than 50 lbs to be serviced. Large Plastic Drums/Burn Barrels

Concrete

Large pieces of Metal

Yard Waste

Liquid Waste or Hazardous Waste

Tires

Tires on Rims

Non-latex Paints & Varnishes

Motor Oil & Solvents

Batteries

Regulated Medical Wastes

Construction Materials.

Appliances that contain Freon, such as Refrigerators & Air Conditioners.

<u>*These items can be accepted if the Freon is removed and the appliance is</u> <u>tagged by a licensed facility that the Freon is removed.</u>

Any additional items that are listed by the Michigan DEQ as banned from Michigan Landfills.
