CITY OF JONESVILLE RESIDENTS ARE REMINDED TO BAG, BARREL, OR BUNDLE FOR WEEKLY YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Weekly yard waste collection will begin for residential homes in the City of Jonesville on May 1st and will continue through October 27th. Residents are reminded that all materials placed for weekly collection must be placed in biodegradable paper bags, labelled barrels or bundles. Loose materials will not be picked up during the weekly collection. Tree limbs and brush must be trimmed to lengths of not more than five feet and bundled. The maximum weight of each package or bundle is 50 pounds. Quantities greater than a pick-up truck load will not be collected.

Residents with larger quantities of brush and yard waste left over from winter storms may request that a dump truck be delivered to their house that they may load themselves. Trucks are available on a first-come basis during working hours of the Department of Public Works. Contact City Hall at (517) 849-2104 to reserve a truck.

All materials for pick up must be placed at the edge of the street no later than 7:30 a.m. the scheduled day of collection and not more than one day prior to collection. Please do not place materials in the street.
