CITY OF JONESVILLE ADJUSTS OPERATIONS TO PROTECT STAFF AND RESIDENTS – COVID-19

In an effort to protect our residents and staff and to ensure continuity of essential City operations during the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic, all City facilities, including City Hall, will be closed to the public effective Monday, November 16, 2020 until further notice. Although offices are closed, all essential City services are fully operational and will continue.

During this time, business can be conducted with the City over the telephone, via email or online. Residents can make sewer and water utility payments on the City's website at www.jonesville.org or by using the secure drop box on the Evans Street side of City Hall.

"The City appreciates our residents' patience and understanding as we take these steps to protect our staff and community," said City Manager Jeff Gray. "Please continue to take precautions to help stop the spread of COVID-19."
