2023 Residential Leaf Collection Program

The City of Jonesville will collect fall leaves for City residents, beginning Monday, October 23rd. The Department of Public Works (DPW) will make several passes through town with the leaf vac, with the final collection scheduled for the week of November 13th.

Please Remember:


- Leaves may be raked to the edge of the curb or to the shoulder of your street in piles, beginning Monday, October 23rd.
- The DPW staff will begin collection in Area 1 (shown on the map on the reverse side of this page) and will proceed to Area 2, then 3, then 4, before returning to Area 1. The staff will make several passes through town during the collection program.
- It is difficult to predict when the vac will be in your neighborhood. The speed of the collection is dependent on a number of factors, including the quantity of leaves raked in an area and the weather. Some neighborhoods may get picked up twice in a week and others once every other week, depending upon conditions.
- Be careful to keep leaves away from storm sewer catch basins that can become clogged by leaves, and cause flooding in the event of rain.
- Brush, twigs, rocks, walnuts, and concrete can damage the leaf vac and delay leaf collection. Please separate these and other similar items from leaf piles. Leaves will not be collected if these items are found in the leaf pile.
- Leaf collection is dependent upon the weather and the season. We appreciate your patience if we have to adjust the program and extend the collection season to address conditions.

Important:

- The last leaf collection is scheduled for the week of November 13th. Please rake all leaves to the curb no later than 7:30 a.m. on Monday, November 13th.
- If the leaf vac passes through your neighborhood before November 13th, there will be a final collection the week of the 13th.
- Updates or extensions to the collection schedule, due to weather of other conditions will be posted on the City's website at www.jonesville.org; on Facebook at www.facebook.com/jonesville.michigan; submitted to the Hillsdale Daily News and to WCSR, Radio Hillsdale (FM 92.1).
- Weekly Yard Waste Collection will continue until October 27th. Please separate yard waste from leaves and continue to follow Yard Waste Collection guidelines, including bundling, barreling, or bagging yard waste.



Collection Areas:



- Area 1 All streets east of the St. Joseph River and north of Chicago Street/US-12
- Area 2 East Chicago Street/US-12, West Street, Maumee Street, and East Street
- Area 3 All other streets south of Chicago Street/US-12 and east of the St. Joseph River
- Area 4 All streets west of the St. Joseph River
