**4. A. Resolution 2014-16 Approving Agreement Pursuant to
MCL 117.14 with Fayette Township**

[ROLL CALL] [Action Item]

As you know, the Home Rule Cities Act provides for a division of the assets held by the Township, following city incorporation. The portion of those assets paid to the Township for the provision of services by the taxpayers of Jonesville is intended to be transferred to the City, under the law. It is common that cities and townships will negotiate for a reasonable division of those assets. Representatives of the City and Fayette Township have been meeting over several weeks and have arrived at a proposed division, as indicated in the attached agreement. The Township is expected to approve the agreement at a special meeting on Tuesday, September 30th at 7:00 p.m. I believe that the attached agreement represents a division that is reasonable to the taxpayers of both jurisdictions and recommend approval of the resolution. A motion and roll call vote are required to approve the resolution. *Please refer to the attached Resolution 2014-16.*
