6. A. Compensation Study Recommendation – Rahmberg, Stover and Associates [Action Item]

In October of 2018, the City Council awarded a contract to complete a compensation study for the City's 14 full-time staff to Rahmberg, Stover and Associates. The purpose of the study was to consider the competitiveness of the current compensation for these positions and to develop a revised pay scale. Jeff Rahmberg will be in attendance at the special meeting to present the findings of the market study and the recommendations for the adoption of a new wage scale. A written report has been prepared, as well. There is considerable data included in the report. To save on paper printing, the study is being emailed to you. If you prefer a paper copy, please contact City Hall and we will get one to you.

The presentation is being made at this time so that the recommendations can be incorporated into the Fiscal Year 2019-20 budget. It is recommended that the City Council consider a motion to accept the study, after any questions have been addressed.
