**6. E. Resolution 2021-07 – State Disaster Contingency Fund**

**[Action Item]**

Governor Gretchen Whitmer declared a State of Emergency as a result of storm damage from the August 12<sup>th</sup> storms that impacted the City. The State of Michigan will consider reimbursement of some public expenditures for response to the event. Much of the public cost for damage to City facilities is being covered by the City's property insurance. However, the City has identified \$4,103.00 in direct costs attributable to the event. These include fuel and equipment costs, as well as Fire Department wages. The State of Michigan requires that the request for reimbursement be accompanied by the attached resolution. The resolution must be approved by roll call vote. *Please refer to the attached resolution.*

**STATE DISASTER CONTINGENCY FUND GRANT  
RESOLUTION**

BE IT RESOLVED BY JONESVILLE CITY COUNCIL (1) OF CITY OF JONESVILLE (2),

WHEREAS, CITY OF JONESVILLE (2), Michigan, is a political subdivision within the State of Michigan with an official Emergency Operations plan in compliance with Section 19 of the Emergency Management Act, Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended.

WHEREAS, CITY OF JONESVILLE (2), sustained severe losses of major proportions brought on by the AUGUST 12, 2021 STRAIGHT LINE WINDS (3) resulting in the following conditions: ROOF BLOWN OFF CITY HALL, MANY TREES DOWN AND ROADS BLOCKED

WHEREAS, JONESVILLE CITY COUNCIL (1) certifies that the COUNTY (5) Emergency Operations Plan was implemented at the onset of the disaster at 0600 AM (6) and all applicable disaster relief forces identified therein were exhausted. \_\_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, as a direct result of the disaster, public damage and expenditures were extraordinary and place an unreasonably great financial burden on CITY OF JONESVILLE (2) totaling \$4,103.00 (7).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT JONESVILLE CITY COUNCIL (1) requests the Governor authorize a grant to the CITY OF JONESVILLE (2) from the State Disaster Contingency Fund pursuant to Section 19, Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended.

FURTHERMORE, JEFF GRAY (8) is authorized to execute for and in behalf of CITY OF JONESVILLE (2) the application for financial assistance and to provide to the State any information required for that purpose.
