6. A. Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget Recommendation

The appointed budget committee of Chair Don Toffolo, Don Germann, Bob Snow and I met and prepared the enclosed recommendations for the 2016-17 fiscal year budget that begins on July 1st. Revenues remain fairly flat, so the budget continues to focus on maintenance of the Downtown infrastructure and debt service. The budget proposes over \$100,000 in maintenance projects to the north and south parking lots, which would be paid from fund balance.
