6. A. MDOT Traffic Signal Modernization Project

[Discussion/Action]

As was discussed in January and at the September 12th regular meeting, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) intention to complete a signal modernization project in 2019. The project would result in the replacement of the decorative mast arms that support the intersection traffic signals along Chicago Street at the Downtown intersections. The replacement signals are referred to as "box spans" and include a single galvanized pole on each corner of the intersection and wires spanning each of the four legs of the intersection to support the signals.

MDOT representatives will attend the Special Meeting on the 20th. The purpose of the meeting is to allow MDOT to provide further explanation of the project, to answer questions, and to discuss options related to enhancements and upgrades that might take place to improve upon the standard galvanized poles.

The City Council is being invited to attend this meeting, as well. Council will meet on the evening of September 20th and has reserved a spot for discussion and action as may be needed on their agenda.

The cost sheets that were provided at the September 12th meeting are included, as is a copy of the Powerpoint that was reviewed at that time.
