JONESVILLE STREET PAVING PROJECTS

The City of Jonesville will soon begin two street paving projects.

A project to repave Jermaine Street and Jonesville Road from US-12/Chicago Street to the west City Limit will begin on May 7, 2018. The project is expected to be completed by June 30, 2018.

During the project, all of the existing asphalt pavement will be pulverized. The base will be graded and new asphalt installed. Some asphalt and concrete driveway approaches will be replaced, as well.

The streets will be closed to through-traffic during the duration of the project. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes and to obey the posted detour.

Also, a project to repave Adrian Street from Maumee Street to the east City Limit will begin on June 11, 2018. The project is expected to be completed by June 30, 2018.

During the project, a layer of the existing asphalt pavement will be removed and a new layer of asphalt will be added.

The street will remain open to at least one lane of traffic during the project. Motorists are advised to expect delays during construction and are asked to please be cautious when travelling through the construction zone.

Street construction is weather dependent and the project schedule may change in the event of rain.
