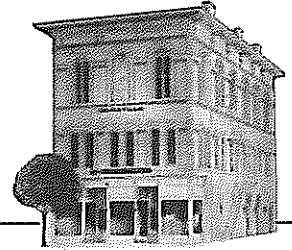

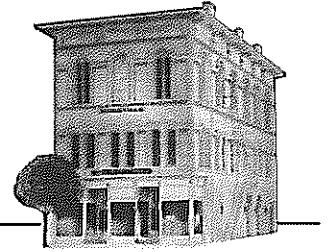

## **E.1 Public Hearing-Ordinance 208**

The purpose of this public hearing is to hear commentary on proposed language for Ordinance 208 which would regulate Medical Marihuana Caregiver Grow Operations.

## **E.2 Ordinance 208-Action Item**

Action item associated with the Public Hearing regarding Ordinance 208. After several months of discussion and development, Ordinance 208 was crafted with the needs and requirements of the Planning Commission as well as requirements under the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act. This proposed ordinance would permit Medical Marihuana Caregiver Grow Operations to operate as a Special Land Use in areas zoned as Light Industrial. This ordinance is in compliance with Drug Free School Zones. It is important to note that this ordinance is intended to regulate Medical Marihuana Caregiver Grow Operations. This ordinance does not regulate Medical Marihuana patients.

The purpose of this action item is to make a recommendation to Village Council on whether or not to adopt this ordinance. The municipal attorney has reviewed the language in the proposed ordinance and has determined that the language is legally sound. At this time, it is my recommendation that the Planning Commission take action to approve and recommend the proposed ordinance language to the Village Council. Should this be approved by the Planning Commission, Village Council would be in a position to set a public hearing and vote on the proposed ordinance at the regularly scheduled meeting in August.
